Day 1 - November 1 - Tuesday: USA - Tel Aviv
Flight to Tel Aviv.

Day 2 - November 2 - Wednesday: Arrival - Ashkelon
Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport near Tel-Aviv. Meeting and assistance by Coral Travel & Tours representative inside the terminal. Transfer to your hotel in Ashkelon for dinner and overnight.

Day 3 - November 3 - Thursday: Ashdod - Caesarea - Mt. Carmel - Nazareth
This morning drive to the port of Ashdod in order to get your motor-cycles. Drive along the coast to **Caesarea**, the seat of the Roman Procurator of Judea at the time of the Christ, and the site where Peter converted the centurion Cornelius. This fortified harbor city was built 2000 years ago by King Herod the Great. View the ruins of Roman, Byzantine and Crusader times. Explore the Roman Theater and the Aqueducts. Drive up **Mt. Carmel** will bring us to the site where Elijah challenged and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal. Drive along the **Armageddon Valley** to **Nazareth**, the home of Joseph and Mary. End your day in Nazareth. Dinner and overnight: Hotel in Nazareth

Day 4 - November 4 - Friday: Nazareth - Cana - Sea of Galilee
The day starts with a visit to the **Church of the Annunciation** and the **Synagogue**. Continue to the city of **Cana of Galilee**, where Jesus performed his first miracle, turning jars of water into wine. Stop at **Golani Junction** for **tree planting**. Continue to the **Mt. of Beatitudes**, site of the Sermon on the Mount. Visit **Capernaum**, the town where Jesus made his home after leaving Nazareth. View the remains of the ancient synagogue, in which he may have preached, and the house of Peter. If we get the permit we visit an **Army Base**. End the day with a visit to **Kibbutz Ginosar** and visit "**Jesus Boat**". Dinner and overnight: Hotel near the Sea of Galilee.

Day 5 - November 5 - Saturday: Golan Heights - Sea of Galilee
The day starts with a **boat ride** on the Sea of Galilee. You then drive to **Caesarea Philippi**, where Peter made his confession of faith to Jesus. Via a ride through the Golan Heights stop at **Mt. Bental** for panoramic view. Drive to **Kibbutz Gesher** and visit **Old Gesher** and the **bridges**. End the day at **Yardenit** with an opportunity to be baptized. Dinner and overnight: Hotel near the Sea of Galilee.

Day 6 - November 6 - Sunday: Bet She'an - Megiddo - Latrun - Jerusalem

After breakfast drive to **Bet She'an**. Recent excavations have unveiled the impressive ruins of the country's largest city in the Roman and Byzantine periods, which was destroyed by an earthquake in 749 AD. Continue to **Megiddo**, the Fortress City of King Solomon, later built again by King Ahab. The books of Daniel and Revelation will come alive as we study about the final Battle of Armageddon while viewing the Plains of Jezreel. Drive to Tel Aviv. A **special convoy from Tel Aviv to Jerusalem** with a stop at **Latrun**, the Armor Corps museum. Enter the city of **Jerusalem** in the traditional way and view the city from **Mt. Scopus**. End your day at the **Western Wall**, last remnant of the second Jewish Temple during the time of Jesus. Dinner and overnight: Hotel near Jerusalem.

Day 7 - November 7 - Monday: Jerusalem

After breakfast we will ascend the **Mount of Olives** (Matthew 24:3, Luke 21:37) for a breathtaking panoramic view of the old city of Jerusalem. Walk along the **Palm Sunday Way** to the **Garden of Gethsemane** (Matthew 26:36-46, Luke 22:39-45, Mark 14:32-42) where Jesus spent the last night before he was arrested. Drive along the "**Last Way**" to Mt. Zion. Cross the **Kidron Valley** and see the **Tombs of Absalom, Zachary and James**. Drive to **Mount Zion** and visit the house of the high priest **Caiphas**. Visit the **Church of Peter in Gallicantu** (Matthew 26:31-35). This is the place where Peter denied the Lord 3 times. On to **The Last Supper Room** (Matthew 26: 17-25). End your day with a service at the **Garden Tomb**. Dinner and overnight: Hotel near Jerusalem.

Day 8 - November 8 - Tuesday: Jerusalem - Masada - Ein Gedi

Early morning drive to **Mt Moriah**. Visit the **Western Wall**, Walk up to the Temple site and visit the **Dome of the Rock** and **El Aqsa Mosque**. Visit to **Yad Vashem** the National Holocaust Museum Depart from Jerusalem and drive along the shores of the Dead Sea to **Massada**. Ascend Massada by cable car. Massada is the site of the most dramatic act in Jewish History. Explore the ancient excavation of Herod's Palaces, the bathhouse, the storerooms, the Ramp, and the oldest Synagogue in the world. On to **Ein Gedi**, an Oasis on the Dead Sea shore. Near the 200 meter high waterfall is a cave where David had his famous meeting with King Saul (First Samuel 24: 1-23). A walk around the reservation confirms that Ein Gedi is one of the most beautiful reservations in the world. Dinner and overnight: Hotel near Jerusalem.

Day 9 - November 9 - Wednesday: Beer Sheba - Ofkim - Shderot - Ashdod - Departure

After breakfast drive to **Beer Sheba**, the capital of the Negev Desert. Continue via **Ofakim** and **Shderot** to **Ashdod**, where you will return to motor-cycles. Drive back to Jerusalem. **Farewell dinner**. Transfer to the airport for your flight back to the USA.

Day 10 - November 10 - Thursday: Jerusalem - Tel Aviv - USA
Your flight departs around midnight. Arrive USA the same day.
